YORKSHIRE (WEST RIDING) AND DISTRICT  
(FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE)  
ORDER OF 1921 (No. 2).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Control of Movement) Order of 1920, or in the Yorkshire (West Riding) and District (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1921, an animal may, subject as hereinafter provided, be moved by road from any premises not-situate within any District which is for the time being a Scheduled District for the purposes of an Order of the Minister relating to foot-and-mouth disease to any slaughterhouse in the borough of Doncaster if accompanied by a Movement Licence granted by an Inspector of the Local Authority of the said borough.

2.—(i) A Movement Licence under this Order shall not be granted by an Inspector of a Local Authority unless he is satisfied that the proposed movement will not involve movement on a road in the Scheduled District except in the borough of Doncaster.

(ii) The provisions of Part IV. of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Control of Movement) Order of 1920 shall apply to animals moved with a licence under this Order.

3. This Order may be cited as the YORKSHIRE (WEST RIDING) AND DISTRICT (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1921 (No. 2).

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF  
AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 23RD MAY 1921.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts,

1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Authorisation of Landing of Animals for  
Exceptional Purposes.*

1. The landing of the animals described in the First Schedule hereto, which are intended for exceptional purposes, is hereby allowed, subject to the provisions of Part II. (Quarantine) of the Third Schedule to the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, and of the Foreign Animals (Quarantine) Order of 1896, and of this Order.

*Definition of Quarantine Station.*

2. The premises described in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby defined as a Foreign Animals Quarantine Station for the purpose of the landing and detention of the animals described in the First Schedule hereto.

*Regulations Applicable to the Animals on  
Landing.*

3. The animals on being landed shall forthwith be moved under the supervision of an Inspector of the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries from the quay to the premises described in the Second Schedule hereto, and shall be there detained for a period of twenty-eight days, and during such period no other animal shall be moved into such premises.
