PUBLIC HEALTH (TUBERCULOSIS)
REGULATIONS, 1921.

By the Public Health (Tuberculosis) Regulations, 1921, dated April 21st, 1921, the Minister of Health has amended the Public Health (Tuberculosis) Regulations, 1912, providing for the notification and treatment of Tuberculosis, with respect to the definitions therein of the expressions Tuberculosis Dispensary and Sanatorium, and with respect to certain duties of the Medical Officer of Health.
