The following Statutes made by the Governing Body of Sidney Sussex College, Cambridge, on the 16th day of June, 1921, and sealed on the same day, have been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of their having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1877."

STATUTES to alter and amend the Statutes of Sidney Sussex College in the University of Cambridge which amending Statutes were duly made at a meeting of the Governing Body of the College specially summoned for this purpose and held on the 16th day of June, 1921, and having been passed at such meeting by the votes of more than two-thirds of the persons present and voting are now submitted for the approval of His Majesty the King in Council.

We The Master Fellows and Scholars of Sidney Sussex College in the University of

Cambridge in exercise of the powers given to us by the 54th Section of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1877 do hereby alter and amend the Statutes of our said College by repealing the whole body of the existing Statutes including those made by us on the 6th and 13th of December 1920 but not yet approved by His Majesty and by substituting therefor the following Statutes:

## CHAPTER I.

### *Of the Constitution of the College.*

1. The College of the Lady Frances Sidney Sussex shall consist of a Master, ten Fellows, and thirty-six Scholars.

2. The Governing Body of the College shall be the Master and Fellows (excluding Honorary Fellows and Research Fellows).

3. If at any time it shall appear to the Governing Body that the revenue of the College is greater than the amount required to afford to each Fellow a dividend of two hundred and fifty pounds (£250) a year, they may submit to the Visitor a scheme approved by the
