CALNE CORPORATION GAS.

(SPECIAL ORDER.)

(Purchase of Undertaking of Calne Gas and Coke Company Limited; Maintenance and Continuance of Undertaking and Supply of Gas; Purchase and Use of Additional Lands for Gasworks Purposes; General Provisions with regard to Supply of Gas; Confirmation of Agreement; Borrowing of Money and Creation of Stock and other Financial Provisions; Incorporation, Repeal and Amendment of Acts and Order and other Matters.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Calne (hereinafter called “the Corporation” and “the Borough” respectively), whose address is the Town Hall, Calne, Wilts, for a Special Order (hereinafter called “the Order”) under and in pursuance of the Gas and Water Works Facilities Act, 1870, the Gas and Water Works Facilities Act, 1870, Amendment Act, 1873, and the Gas Regulation Act, 1920, for all or some of the following amongst other purposes (that is to say):—

1. To empower the Corporation to acquire the undertaking of the Calne Gas and Coke Company Limited (hereinafter called “the Company”), including their property, goodwill, assets, effects, powers, rights, privileges, liberties and authorities, to provide for the transfer to and vesting in the Corporation of the said undertaking, the issue by the Corporation of stock to the shareholders, the payment of the Company’s debts and liabilities, and the winding-up and dissolution of the Company, and to confirm and authorize the carrying into effect of an agreement entered into between the Company and the Corporation and any other agreements that may be entered into by the said parties

before the granting of the Order for or relating to the sale and purchase of the undertaking or otherwise.

2. To confer upon the Corporation all or some of the powers contained in the Calne Gas Order, 1883, relating to the Company’s gas undertaking, or to repeal the said Order and to re-enact with amendments and to make applicable to the Corporation and to their proposed area of supply all or some of the enactments contained therein.

3. The proposed area of supply is as follows:—

The parish of Calne Within, in the county of Wilts, and so much of the parishes of Calne Without, Bremhill, Cherhill, Compton Bassett, Heddington and Hilmarton, in the county of Wilts, as is within a radius of three and a half miles from the principal entrance of the gasworks of the Corporation.

4. To empower the Corporation to carry on the gas undertaking of the Company acquired by them, and to maintain, alter, improve, enlarge, renew or discontinue the Company’s gas works, and to make, store, purchase, convert, prepare, produce, supply and deal in gas and all residual products arising directly or indirectly from the manufacture of gas upon the lands which are now used or authorized to be used for the making of gas by the Company, including the lands described in the Schedule to the Calne Gas Order, 1883, and also upon the following lands proposed to be acquired by the Corporation:—

1. All those seven several messuages, cottages or tenements, together with the gardens, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging, situate and being in Kew-lane, in the parish of Calne Within (formerly the parish of Calne), in the county of Wilts, belonging or reputed to belong to the trustees of John Dolman Baily, deceased, and which said messuages, cottages or tenements, gardens and premises are now in the occupation of G. Ponting, F. Croft, W. Burgess, Henry Angell, Bert Angell, Wm. Angell and Herbert Salter.

2. All that triangular piece of land situate on the banks of the River Marden and abutting upon a public footpath leading from Horsebrook to Kew-lane, in the said parish of Calne Within, now and for many years past in the occupation of a basket maker William Weston by name, which said piece of land adjoins the last-mentioned cottages, hereditaments and premises on the south-west side thereof, and belongs to Harris (Calne) and the General Produce Company Limited.

All which hereditaments described as Nos. 1 and 2 are bounded on the north-west side by the Gas Works and property belonging to the Calne Gas and Coke Company, Limited, on the north-east side by Kew-lane aforesaid, and on the south and south-west sides by a street called Horsebrook.

3. All that cottage, yard and premises situate in the street called Horsebrook in the parish of Calne Within, in the county of Wilts, now and for some time past in the occupation of Eliza Bennett, adjoining on the north and east sides thereof to cottages and premises belonging to the Undertakers.

5. To authorize the Corporation to supply gas for public, domestic, trade and other purposes within the area hereinbefore defined.
