COAL MINES ACT.

THE SAFETY LAMPS ORDER OF THE 18TH JUNE, 1921.

In pursuance of Section 33 of the Coal Mines Act, 1911 (a) and of the Mining Industry Act, 1920, (b) the Board of Trade hereby make the following Order:—

1. The types of safety lamps named and described in Parts I and II of the Schedule to this Order are approved, until further order, for use in all mines to which the Coal Mines Act, 1911, applies, subject to the conditions specified in the Schedule.

2. The Schedules to previous Orders made under Section 33 of the Coal Mines Act, 1911, shall take effect subject to the amendments set forth in Part III of the Schedule to this Order.

3. This Order may be cited as "The Safety Lamps Order of the 18th June, 1921."
