CHICHESTER.

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen, and Citizens of the City of Chichester (hereinafter called the Corporation), being the Urban District Council for the said City, have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, to partially repeal, alter, or amend the Chichester Corporation Water Act, 1897, so as:—

(1) To authorize the Corporation to construct and maintain an addition to the existing engine house at Old Fishbourne, in the Parish of Bosham, and new engine and pump there, and one or more reservoirs in the Parish of Lavant with conduits, mains and lines of pipes in connection therewith;

(2) To confer further borrowing powers upon the Corporation for the construction of the said additional waterworks, for distributing mains and for the general purposes of their waterworks undertaking;

(3) For the purpose of the laying of conduits, mains and lines of pipes, to make applicable to the waterworks undertaking of the Corporation the provisions of Section 54 of the Public Health Act, 1875 (which relate to the carrying of watermains by a local authority within or without their district) and any provisions of that Act incidental thereto, including the provisions of Section 108 (Compensation in case of Damage by Local Authority) of the Act, and to provide that for the purposes of those provisions as made applicable to the waterworks undertaking the limits of the Corporation for the supply of water shall be deemed to be the limits of the Local Authority; and

(4) For the several purposes of the application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment to the said Local Act, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Statutory Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, in force in the said City as may be necessary or desirable;

and whereas it is proposed that a Provisional Order should be issued in compliance with the said Application:

Esquire, M.Inst.C.E., one of the Inspectors of the Ministry of Health, will attend at the Council Chamber, Chichester, on Tuesday, the twenty-seventh day of September, 1921, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, to hold a Local Inquiry into the subject-matter of the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.

And notice is hereby further given, that any person interested may attend at such Inquiry and be heard with reference to the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.
