The maximum prices now authorised in respect of the supply of gas by the Undertakers are:—

(a) Within the Borough and Parish of Chelmsford, and the Parishes of Springfield, Broomfield, Great Baddow and Widford, five shillings and sevenpence halfpenny per thousand cubic feet.

(b) Beyond the Parish and Borough of Chelmsford, and the Parishes of Springfield, Broomfield, Great Baddow and Widford, six shillings and fourpence halfpenny per thousand cubic feet.

And the maximum prices which the Undertakers have asked the Board of Trade to substitute for these prices in accordance with paragraph (b) above are:—

(1) Within the Borough and Parish of Chelmsford, and the Parishes of Springfield, Broomfield, Great Baddow and Widford, one shilling and tenpence per therm.

(2) Beyond the Borough and Parish of Chelmsford, and the Parishes of Springfield, Broomfield, Great Baddow and Widford, two shillings and decimal one seven of a penny per therm.
