(a) For the above General Minimum Time-Rates, Single Spinners are to shift a carriage and all Spinners are to clean and blow down frames, to start and stop frames when required, and to perform other usual Spinners' duties.

(b) The above general Minimum Time-Rates apply to Spinners employed on the ordinary Flyer frame commonly in use in the Jute Trade, when the size of yarn used on a bobbin is not greater than the normal size as specified in this sub-section, namely:—

SECTION V.—In the case of Single Spinners or Double Spinners (other than Orra (or Spare) Spinners), when the size of yarn used on a bobbin is greater than the normal size of yarn as specified in Section IV. above, the General Minimum Time-Rates shall be equivalent to the appropriate General Minimum Time-Rates, as set out in the preceding Section, with the addition of the following percentages:—

Size of Bobbin.	Percentage increases to be paid on the appropriate rates, as set out in Section IV. above, for sizes above the Normal Size of Yarn.

(a) In respect of any intermediate size of yarn the percentage increase for the next higher size shall be paid.

(b) This scale supersedes all allowances previously made for size or twist. Nothing extra shall be paid for weft and no deduction shall be made for hard warp.
