3.-(1) The animals on being landed shall forthwith be moved under the supervision of an Inspector of the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries from the quay to the premises described in the Second Schedule hereto, and shall be there detained for a period of twentyeight days, and during such period no other animals shall be moved into such premises.

(2) The animals shall not be moved out of the Foreign Animals Quarantine Station defined in this Order until the expiration of the prescribed period of detention and until the animals, after such expiration, have been examined by a Veterinary Inspector of the Ministry, and declared by him to be free from disease and from the conditions imposed by the said Order of 1896 and this Order.

This condition is substituted for the fifth condition in Article 3 of the said Order of 1896 in respect of the said animals.
