Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915:
Further extension of time for operation of certain provisions of the Mall Approach (Improvement) Act, 1914.

COUNTY OF LONDON.

To the London County Council:—
And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by virtue of sub-section (2) of Section 2 of the Mall Approach (Improvement) Act, 1914 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1914"), and of Orders dated respectively the 26th day of March, 1917, the 1st day of August, 1918, and the 21st day of May, 1919, issued by the Local Government Board, and of an Order dated the 7th day of July, 1920, issued by the Minister of Health, under Section 1 of the Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1915"), the time limited for the exercise of the powers of the London County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") for the compulsory purchase of lands under the Act of 1914, expired on the 7th day of August, 1921;

And whereas by virtue of Section 8 of the Act of 1914, and of the above-recited Orders of the 21st day of May, 1919, and the 7th day of July, 1920, the powers of the Council under that Act for the execution of the improvements specified in Section 3 of that Act also ceased on the 7th day of August, 1921;

And whereas by the operation of the Ministry of Transport Act, 1919, the powers of the Local Government Board and of the Minister of Health in relation to the subject-matter of this Order were transferred to the Minister of Transport;

And whereas in pursuance of the said Section 1 of the Act of 1915 the Council applied to the Minister of Transport before the expiration of the time limited as aforesaid for an Order extending that time:

Now, therefore, the Minister of Transport, in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 1 of the Act of 1915, and of any other powers in that behalf, hereby extends until the 7th day of August, 1922, the time limited as aforesaid for the exercise of the powers of the Council—

(a) for the compulsory purchase of lands under the Act of 1914; and

(b) for the execution of the improvements specified in Section 3 of the Act of 1914.

Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915:
Extending time limited by Section 22 of the London County Council (Tramways and Improvements) Act, 1913.

WHEREAS by virtue of Section 22 of the London County Council (Tramways and Improvements) Act, 1913 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1913"), and of an Order dated the 7th day of July, 1920, issued by the Minister of Health under Section 1 of the Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1915"), the time limited for the completion of the works therein referred to, including the works in connection with the widening of the Strand and the alteration of the level of a portion of Durham House Street, authorised by Sections 11 and 12 of the Act of 1913, expired on the 15th day of August, 1921;

And whereas by the operation of the Ministry of Transport Act, 1919, the powers of the Minister of Health in relation to the subject-matter of this Order were transferred to the Minister of Transport;

And whereas in pursuance of the said Section 1 of the Act of 1915 the Council applied to the Minister of Transport before the expiration of the time limited as aforesaid for an Order extending that time:

Now, therefore, the Minister of Transport, in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 1 of the Act of 1915, and of any other powers in that behalf, hereby extends until the 15th day of August, 1922, the time limited as aforesaid for the completion of the works authorised by Sections 11 and 12 of the Act of 1913.
