At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 11th day of October, 1921.

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS there was this day read at the Board a Memorial from the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, dated the 14th day of September, 1921 (N.13529/21), in the words following, viz. :—

“ Whereas by Section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act, 1865, it is enacted, *inter alia*, that all pay, pensions or other allowances in the nature thereof payable in respect of services in Your Majesty's Naval or Marine Force to a person being or having been an Officer, Seaman or Marine therein shall be paid in such manner and subject to such restrictions, conditions and provisions as are from time to time directed by Order in Council :

“ And whereas we consider that the rates of pay of Seedie and Kroomen ratings of Your Majesty's Navy should be increased to meet present conditions :

“ We beg leave humbly to recommend that Your Majesty may be graciously pleased by

Your Order in Council to sanction payment as from the dates indicated of the rates of pay indicated in the attached schedule, power being reserved to us to vary the rates within the scale laid down or to associate payment with such conditions as may be deemed necessary.

“ The Lords Commissioners of Your Majesty's Treasury have signified their concurrence in these proposals.
