## Particulars of Agreement.

During the period up to the 31st December, 1921, the wages payable to all male workers of 21 years of age and over employed in agriculture shall be not less than 37s. 6d. for a week of 50 hours (excluding Sunday); all time in excess of 50 hours per week (excluding Sunday) to be paid for at the rate of 10d. per hour, and all employment on a Sunday to be payable at the rate of 1s. per hour.
