4. Arithmetic.

Candidates must obtain such an aggregate number of marks as to satisfy the Civil Service Commissioners.

5. No Candidate will be admitted to Examination who does not, at such time as may be fixed by the Civil Service Commissioners, produce an undertaking signed by her Parent or Guardian, that she will, if successful, reside either with her parents or guardians, or with relations or friends approved by such parents or guardians.

6. Candidates must be at least 5 feet in height.

7. Persons holding situations in the Civil Service must obtain the permission of the authorities of their Department to attend the Examination before the commencement of the competition.

8. Persons who have entered upon or completed a course of education or training for the occupation of teacher, on account of which grants are payable from the Exchequer, will not be qualified to receive appointments until the consent of the Board of Education in England, the Committee of Council on Education for Scotland, or the Commissioners of National Education, Ireland, as the case may be, given in conformity with rules sanctioned by the Lords of the Treasury, has been notified to the Civil Service Commissioners.

9. Application for permission to attend an Examination must be made at such time and in such manner as may be fixed by the Civil Service Commissioners.

10. A fee of 3s. will be required from every Candidate attending an Examination.

NORTHUMBERLAND AUDIT DISTRICT.

The Minister of Health hereby certifies the appointment to the office of District Auditor of William Llewelyn Brett (hereinafter referred to as "the District Auditor"), and in pursuance of the provisions of Section 4 of the District Auditors Act, 1879, and the other enactments in that behalf, the Minister hereby orders and prescribes as follows:—

1. It shall be the duty of the District Auditor to audit the Accounts of the Authorities, and the Officers of the Authorities, described in the Schedule to this Order, so far as those Accounts are for the time being subject to be audited by a District Auditor.

2. The District Auditor shall audit the said Accounts according to the provisions of the several Statutes and of the Orders issued by competent authority in force for the time being in that behalf, and shall perform all such duties and exercise all such powers in connection with the audit of such Accounts as are prescribed and conferred by the said Statutes and Orders.

3. The District in which the District Auditor shall act as Auditor, and which is hereby assigned to him for the performance of his duties under this Order, shall be termed "The Northumberland Audit District," and shall, until the Minister otherwise directs, comprise the districts or areas subject to the jurisdiction

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of the several Authorities described in the Schedule to this Order.

4. This Order shall take effect notwithstanding any Order in force assigning a District to a District Auditor or prescribing his duties, but nothing in this Order shall affect or interfere with the existing duties and powers of any District Auditor as regards any Audit of which notice has already been given or any matters or proceedings already commenced.

5. This Order shall come into operation on the date hereof.
