

**ELLESMERE PORT AND WHITBY.**

Whereas the Urban District Council of Ellesmere Port and Whitby have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, to partially repeal, alter or amend the Ellesmere Port and Whitby Urban District Council Act, 1914, so as to alter from three per centum to four per centum the rate of accumulation for any sinking fund established under that Act:

Notice is hereby given, that it is proposed that a Provisional Order should be issued in regard to the subject matter of the said Application, and that it should for the purpose of the Application, or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on that purpose, make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Act as may be necessary or desirable:

Notice is also given, that the Minister of Health will consider any objections which may be made to him, in writing, before the sixteenth day of December, 1921, by any person who may be affected by or interested in the proposed Provisional Order.

**ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.**

(DATED 29TH NOVEMBER 1921.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Authorisation of Landing of Animals for Exceptional Purposes.*

1. The landing of any ruminating animals or swine, the property of the Zoological Society of London, which are intended for exhibition in the Gardens of that Society, is hereby allowed, subject to the provisions of Part II. (Quarantine) of the Third Schedule to the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, and of the Foreign Animals (Quarantine) Order of 1896, and this Order.

*Definition of Quarantine Station.*

2. The premises described in the Schedule hereto are hereby defined as a Foreign Animals Quarantine Station for the purpose of the landing and detention of any such animals as may be landed in accordance with the provisions of this Order.

*Examination before Landing.*

3. No such animal shall be landed except with a licence granted by an Inspector of the Ministry, which licence shall not be granted unless and until the animal has been examined

by a Veterinary Inspector of the Ministry and certified by him to be free from symptoms of contagious disease.

*Regulation Applicable to Animals on Landing.*

4. Such animals on being landed, shall forthwith be moved under the supervision of an Inspector of the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries from the quay to the premises described in the Schedule hereto, and shall be there detained for a period of twenty-eight days or such other period as may be specified in the licence authorising the landing of the animals. During the said period the animals shall be kept separate from all other animals, and no other animal shall be moved into such premises.

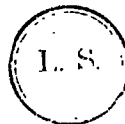
