

shall have held such office or two or more of such offices for twenty years but less than twenty-five years (in addition to his one *modulus*), three-fifths of a *modulus*; for each Fellow elected to his Fellowship after the tenth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and three, who shall have finally ceased to hold a College office as aforesaid or the University office of Regius Professor of Greek on account of ill-health, and shall have been permitted by the Council to retain his Fellowship as a pension Fellowship, and who shall have held such office or two or more of such offices for twenty years but less than twenty-five years (in addition to his one *modulus*), one-half of a *modulus*; and for each Fellow finally ceasing to hold a College office as aforesaid or the University office of Regius Professor of Greek, who shall have held such office or two or more of such offices for twenty-five years (in addition to his one *modulus*), one *modulus*. Provided always that the period of tenure by any Fellow before the approval of this Statute by His Majesty in Council of the office of Dean shall be reckoned for the purposes of this Section as if the office of Dean were included among such College offices as aforesaid.
