

WATER UNDERTAKINGS (MODIFICATION OF CHARGES) ACT, 1921.

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Barnet District Gas and Water Company have made an application to the Minister of Health under the above Act for an Order modifying the Company's existing statutory charges, so as to enable them to make charges for water supply in the water limits within which they are empowered to supply water in accordance with the following:—

(a) Modification of Section 56 of the Barnet District Gas and Water Act, 1872, by substituting the following scale of charges:—

Rack Rent, not exceeding £20, 7½ per cent. on rack rent.

Rack Rent exceeding £20 and not exceeding £30, 6½d. per cent. on rack rent.

Rack Rent exceeding £30, 6¼ per cent. on rack rent.

(b) Modification of Section 57 of the Barnet District Gas and Water Act, 1872, and amendment thereto in Act of 1904, Section 25, s. s. 2, by substituting the following scale of charges:—

Each Water-closet beyond the first, 6s. 3d. per annum.

Each Bath in houses where Rack Rent is less than £40 per annum, 12s. 6d. per annum.

Each Bath beyond the first in houses where Rack Rent amounts to £40 per annum, 15s. per annum.

(c) Modification of Section 46 of the Barnet District Gas and Water Act, 1883, by substituting therein a price of one shilling and threepence per thousand gallons.

(d) Modification of Section 25, sub-sections 3 and 4, of the Barnet District Gas and Water Act, 1904, by the addition of 25 per cent. to the charges authorized therein.

A copy of the application and of all documents submitted to the Minister in connection therewith may be inspected and extracts made therefrom free of charge at the Company's offices at Barnet, between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 12.30 and from 2.30 p.m. until 5 p.m. (except Saturdays).

Where the annual rack rent or value does not exceed £20, at the rate of £13 per centum per annum;

Where such rent or value exceeds £20, at the rate of £12 10s. per centum per annum;

Every water-closet beyond the first, 7s. 6d. per annum;

Every bath (where such rent or value does not exceed £40), 10s. per annum;

Every bath (where such rent or value exceeds £40), 15s. per annum.
