

and until they have been examined by a Veterinary Inspector of the Ministry and certified by him to be free from symptoms of contagious disease.

Regulation Applicable to the Animals on Landing.

4. The animals, on being landed, shall forthwith be moved under the supervision of an Inspector of the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries from the quay to the premises described in the Second Schedule hereto, and shall be there detained for a period of twenty-eight days, and during such period no other animal shall be moved into such premises.
