LAND DRAINAGE ACTS, 1861 AND 1918.

Notice is hereby given, that the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries has settled and made Orders under the Land Drainage Act, 1918, constituting as drainage districts certain lands drained by the River Nene, its tributaries or drains connected therewith, and described above, in the county of Huntingdon, and that the Orders will become final and have effect as Acts of Parliament unless within thirty days from the date of this Notice memorials that the Orders shall not become law without confirmation by Parliament is presented to the Ministry by some person or body affected by the Orders and having such interest as is prescribed by Article 4 of the Land Drainage Regulations, 1918 (Statutory Rules and Orders, 1918, No. 1605), as being sufficient for the purpose.

The particular drainage district in respect of which a memorial is presented must be clearly stated at the time of presenting such memorial.

Copies of the Sealed Orders and of the 6 in. scale maps referred to therein have been deposited at the offices of the Ramsey Urban District Council, Ramsey, Huntingdonshire, for public inspection for the period of thirty days from the date hereof.

LONDON ELECTRIC RAILWAY ACT,
1914.

SPECIAL ACTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT,
1915.

BY virtue and in pursuance of the provisions of the above named Act the Minister of Transport hereby orders that the period limited (1) for the completion of the works authorised by Section 11 of the London Electric Railway Act, 1914, and (2) for the exercise of the powers for the compulsory purchase of (a) lands and easements for the construction of the works described in Section 6, and (b) the additional lands referred to in Section 14 of the said Act of 1914 shall be further extended in each case for one year from the 8th day of July, 1922.
