## HOVE PIER ORDER, 1912.

**B**Y virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915, the Minister of Transport hereby orders that the time limited by Section 17 of the Hove Pier Order, 1912, for the completion of the works authorised by Section 11 of that Order, which has already been extended by six years by Orders made by the Board of Trade on the 24th February, 1916, the 20th November, 1916, the 9th November, 1917, and the 29th October, 1918, and by the Minister of Transport on the 31st December, 1919, and the 22nd December, 1920, shall be extended for a further period of one year.
