The following Statutes made by the Governing Body of Balliol College, Oxford, on the 23rd April, 1920, the 25th May, 1921, and the 21st June, 1921, have been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council and notice of their having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1877":—

STATUTE to alter and amend the Statutes framed by the Commissioners appointed under "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1877" (40 and 41 Vict. c. 48), and approved by Her late Majesty in Council on the Third day of May, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-two, in relation to Balliol College in the University of Oxford as amended by a Statute approved by His Majesty in Council on the Tenth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one.

In the Matter of a Statute concerning "The Fellows" such amending Statute being duly made at a General Meeting of the Governing Body of the said College specially summoned for this purpose, held on the twenty-third day of April, One thousand nine hundred and twenty, and passed by the unanimous vote of those present.

1. In Statute III 16 (d) for "provided that . . . within the College walls" substitute "provided that at least four persons engaged in the Educational work of the College exclusive of the Master shall reside within the College walls."

2. In Statute III 16 (e) for "so long as there are four persons during the usual College terms" substitute "so long as there are four persons exclusive of the Master engaged in the Educational work of the College and resident within the College walls during the usual College terms."
