HINCKLEY GAS

(SPECIAL ORDER).

(Power to Hinckley Urban District Council to Utilise Additional Lands in the Parish and Urban District of Hinckley for Gas Works Purposes; Purchase of Lands; Dwelling-houses for Employees; Retention, Sale and Disposal of Lands; Laying down of Mains in Private Streets and for ancillary purposes; Allowance of Discounts; Charges to Consumers having Separate Supplies and for Supplies by Prepayment Meters; Exemption of Fittings from Distress, &c., Further Provisions for Regulating Supply and User of Gas; Supply of Gas in Bulk to and by the Council; Borrowing, Re-borrowing and Re-payment of Money and other financial matters; Formation and Application of Reserve Fund and other Provisions as to Application of Revenue; Amendment of Hinckley Local Board Gas Act, 1880; Incorporation, Repeal, Amendment of Acts, and other matters.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is being made to the Board of Trade by the Urban District Council of Hinckley (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), whose address is the Council Offices, Hinckley, for a Special Order, hereinafter called "the Order," under and in pursuance of section 10 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920, for all or some of the following, amongst other, purposes (that is to say):—

1. To authorize the Council on the lands hereinafter described, or some part or parts thereof, to erect and maintain, alter, extend, renew and improve additional works for the manufacture, storage, conversion, utilisation, distribution of gas and of residual products arising from, resulting in, or producible from such manufacture, and to make and store gas, and to make, use, store, utilise and distribute all such residual products and materials as aforesaid, and on such lands to construct and maintain houses, buildings and other works connected with their gas undertaking.

The lands hereinbefore referred to are situate in the township and urban district of Hinckley, in the county of Leicester, and are: A piece of land situate near Coventry-road, in the parish and urban district of Hinckley, containing 1,562 square yards or thereabouts and bounded on the north-western side thereof by other property of the Council, on the north-eastern and south-eastern sides thereof by the gasworks of the Council, and on the south-western side thereof by land belonging to Mrs. Elizabeth Ann Lord Herbert.

2. So far as may be necessary or desirable to sanction and confirm the purchase by the Council of the land hereinbefore described.

3. To empower the Council to acquire additional lands for the purposes of their undertaking; to purchase, erect or take on lease dwelling-houses for persons in their employment; to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of lands belonging to them and no longer required by them on such terms and for such period as they think fit, and generally to confer further powers upon the Council with
