Now, therefore, by this Order made in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Section 7 of the British Nationality and Status of Aliens Act, 1914, I revoke the said Certificate, and I direct that such revocation to have

effect from the date hereof.

And I further direct that Julie Marie Kolle, the wife of the said William Frederick Alexander Kolle, shall cease to be a British subject.
