

6. All the jurisdiction, powers, rights, duties and property vested in or possessed by the Lytham Council or the Saint Anne's Council or in or by any person or body in trust for either of those Councils or any of their members as such (and not otherwise dealt with or transferred by or under any part of this Scheme) shall vest in the Corporation and shall be exercised, held and applied for the municipal and public purposes of the Borough.

7. All duties and liabilities which immediately before the commencement of this Scheme attached to and were enforceable against the Lytham Council or the Saint Anne's Council or the property of those Councils respectively shall attach to and be enforceable against the Corporation and the property of the Corporation.

8. Any investigation, legal proceedings, or remedy in respect of any debt, liability, penalty or forfeiture due to or incurred by or on behalf of the Lytham Council or the Saint Anne's Council before the commencement of this Scheme may be continued, prosecuted or enforced by or against the Corporation.

9. The District Fund and General District Rate of the Borough shall for all purposes whatsoever (subject to the provisions of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1882, with respect to the Borough Fund and Borough Rate and Watch Rate respectively) take the place of and be substituted for the District Funds and General District Rates respectively of the Lytham District and of the Saint Anne's District and all sums of money respectively payable to, from, or out of, and all liabilities charged upon or attaching to the District Funds and General District Rates of the said Districts respectively shall (subject as aforesaid) be paid to, from, or out of and shall be charged upon the District Fund and General District Rate of the Borough respectively.

10. All the rights, interests, powers, property, privileges, liabilities or obligations vested in or attached to the Lytham Council under the Lytham Local Acts and Orders mentioned in the First Schedule hereto or in or to the Saint Anne's Council under the Saint Anne's Local Acts and Order mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto or in or to either of the said Councils under any other Statute, or Order, or any Bye-law or Regulation shall pass to, devolve upon, be exercisable by or against, vested in or attached to the Corporation acting by the Council as the Sanitary Authority of the Borough and from and after the commencement of this Scheme the Corporation shall be and continue the legal successors of the Lytham Council and the Saint Anne's Council for all purposes. Provided that the Lytham Local Acts and Orders mentioned in the First Schedule hereto and the Bye-laws mentioned in Part I. of the Fifth Schedule hereto and any other Bye-laws, Regulations or Orders made by the Lytham Council or their predecessors under the Lytham Local Acts and Orders or any Public General Act and in force within the Lytham District at the commencement of this Scheme shall, except in so far as repealed by this Scheme, be operative only within so much of the Borough as comprises the Lytham District, and that the Saint Anne's Local Acts and Order mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto and the Bye-laws mentioned in Part II. of the Fifth Schedule hereto

and any other Bye-laws, Regulations, or Orders made by the Saint Anne's Council or their predecessors under the Saint Anne's Local Acts and Order, or any Public General Act, and in force within the Saint Anne's District at the commencement of this Scheme, shall, except in so far as repealed by this Scheme, be operative only within so much of the Borough as comprises the Saint Anne's District. The Town Clerk and other officers of the Borough shall be substituted for and perform the duties of the Clerks and other officers of the Lytham Council and the Saint Anne's Council respectively.

11. The enactments mentioned in Part I. of the Third Schedule hereto which have been adopted by the Lytham Council shall from the commencement of this Scheme be in force throughout so much of the Borough as comprises the Lytham District and the enactments mentioned in Part II. of the said Schedule which have been adopted by the Saint Anne's Council shall from the commencement of this Scheme be in force throughout so much of the Borough as comprises the Saint Anne's District as if in each case the same had been duly adopted by the Corporation for the said portions of the Borough after the creation thereof.

12. The Orders of the Local Government Board declaring those provisions of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, which are mentioned in the Fourth Schedule hereto to be in force within the Saint Anne's District, shall from the commencement of this Scheme have effect as if the said Orders had declared the said provisions to be in force throughout so much of the Borough as comprises the Saint Anne's District, and the hereinbefore recited Order of that Board declaring Section 50 of the said Act (comprised in Part III. thereof) to be in force within the Lytham District, shall from the commencement of this Scheme have effect as if such Order had declared the said Section to be in force throughout so much of the Borough as comprises the Lytham District.

13. The hereinbefore recited Orders of the Local Government Board made in pursuance of Section 33 of the Local Government Act, 1894, shall from the commencement of this Scheme continue in force and effect within the Borough and in favour of the Corporation as fully as they are now in force within the Lytham District and the Saint Anne's District respectively, and in favour of the Councils of those respective Districts.

14. The hereinbefore recited Order made by the Saint Anne's Council on the 5th day of April, 1911, and confirmed by the Local Government Board on the 14th day of June, 1911, relating to certain trades, businesses or manufactures, shall from the commencement of this Scheme be in force within and apply to so much of the Borough as comprises the Saint Anne's District.

15. Except as hereinafter provided, and subject to the provisions of Clause 10 of this Scheme, the Bye-laws mentioned in the Fifth Schedule hereto and any other Bye-laws, Regulations and Orders made by the Lytham Council and the Saint Anne's Council under the Public Health Act, 1875, the Dairies, Cowsheds and Milkshops Order of 1885, the Shop Hours Act, 1904, the Shops Act, 1912, or any other Public General Act and in force within the Lytham District and the Saint Anne's District at the
