The award of the Distinguished Conduct Medal to No. 7868055 Company Serjeant-Major John Norman Gordon, Tank Corps, when serving as No. 75868 Serjeant, Tank Corps, which was gazetted on the 15th Nov. 1918, is forfeited in consequence of his having been discharged from the Army by sentence of a General Court-Martial.

The award of the Military Medal to Percy Charles Terry (late Lieutenant, Regular Army Reserve of Officers (The Queen's Own Royal West Kent Regiment)), when serving as No. 10062 Corporal, The Queen's (Royal West Surrey Regiment), which was gazetted on the 9th July, 1917, is forfeited in consequence of his having been convicted by the Civil Power.

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
