

public inquiry, prohibit or restrict, subject to such exceptions or conditions as to occasional user or otherwise as may be specified in the Order, the driving of mechanically propelled vehicles of any specified class on any specified highway within the area of the council in any case in which it appears to him, as the result of the inquiry, to be proved that a vehicle of that class cannot be used on that highway without endangering the safety of the vehicle or the persons therein or of other traffic using the highway, or that the highway is unsuitable for use by a vehicle of that class:

And whereas the County Council of Essex have made application to the Minister of Transport for an Order to be made in pursuance of the said sub-section prohibiting or restricting the driving of Heavy Motor Cars and Locomotives on the highways specified in the Schedule hereto:

Notice is hereby given, that R. G. H. Clements, Esquire, M.C., A.M.Inst.C.E., one of the Inspectors of the Ministry of Transport, will attend at the Shire Hall, Chelmsford, on Wednesday, the twenty-fourth day of May, 1922, at half-past eleven o'clock in the forenoon, to hold a Local Inquiry into the subject-matter of the said application:

And notice is hereby further given, that any persons interested may attend such Inquiry, and be heard with reference to the said application: Provided that no person shall be entitled to be heard at the Inquiry unless he has, on or before the twelfth day of May, 1922, sent a notice in writing to the Minister of his desire to be heard at the Inquiry.

SCHEDULE.

County Main Roads.

No. 3 District:—

The Colchester-Harwich road from Elmstead Market via Horseley Cross and Wix to Ramsey.

No. 4 District:—

The Hatfield Peverel-Maldon road from Hatfield Peverel to Langford.

No. 5 District:—

The Great Parndon-Hoddesdon road from Tyler's Cross, Roydon Hamlet, to Dobb's Weir Bridge over the River Lea Navigation.

Urban Districts.

Braintree:—

Bank Street.

Chingford:—

Endlebury Road and Simmond's Lane from Friday Hill to the Sewardstone Road.

Grays:—

(See under Rural District of Orsett.)

Loughton:—

Rectory Lane from the Loughton-Epping road to the Chigwell-Abridge road at "Rolls." (Part of this road is in the Rural District of Epping.)

Waltham Holy Cross:—

Avey Lane from "The Chestnuts" on the Sewardstone road to High Beech.

Road from Avey Lane via Wood Green to Warlies.

Road from the Epping New Road at Amersbury Banks via Cophall Green to the Waltham Abbey-Aimes Green road at Cobbins Brook.

Road from the Sewardstone road about 300 yards south of "The Grange" via Aldersgrove Lodge to High Beech, including the loop via Pipers Farm.

Road from the Sewardstone road at "Woodlands" by Gillwell Park to Sewardstonebury.

Rural Districts.

Billericay:—

Road from Herongate on the Brentwood-Tilbury road to Duntun Waylets.

Road from Burnt Mills via Smiler's Farm to Jackaman's Farm near Bowers Gifford.

Road from the road junction about 800 yards south of Nevendon Church to the Stanford-le-Hope-Pitsea road about one mile west of Pitsea.

Road from Billericay via Laindon Common to the Fortune of War Inn on the Duntun Waylets-Crays Hill road.

Braintree:—

Switch road running through Finchingfield Village about 100 yards south of the Church.

Chelmsford:—

Road from the Great Baddow-Danbury road at Danbury Park via Riffhams to the Danbury-Little Baddow road.

Loop road from the last specified road to the main road at Elm Green, Danbury.

Switch road south of Runsell Green on the Danbury-Maldon road from Spring Cottage to Whitehouse Farm.

Epping:—

The Roydon-Harlow road from Roydon via Horsecroft Common to Netteswell Cross. (See also under Urban District of Loughton.)

Maldon:—

The road from Althorne to Woodham Ferrers Railway Station:—

(i) from the road junction near Althorne Church to the Cold Norton-North Fambridge road, and

(ii) from the Cold Norton-North Fambridge road to the Stow Maries-Woodham Ferrers Station road near Morris Farm.

The Latchingdon-Asheldham road from the Latchingdon-Althorne road near Warden's Farm to the Asheldham-Southminster road.

Ongar:—

Road from the Epping-Ongar road at Upper Bobbingworth Green via Padlers End to the Moreton-Ongar road near Cripsey Brook.

Road from the Abridge-Ongar road near "Lawns" via Navestock Side to the Ongar-Brentwood road at Kelvedon Hatch Common.

The Abridge-Lambourne End road, including both routes from Bishop's Hall to the Chigwell Row-Stapleford Abbott's road.
