PROPOSED CANCELLATION OF GUARANTEED TIME-RATES FOR CERTAIN CLASSES OF FEMALE WORKERS.

The Trade Board propose to cancel the Guaranteed Time-Rates for piece workers at present in force in respect of female workers of 14 and under 18 years of age as set out in Part I of the Trade Board's Notice H.L. (8) dated 7th March, 1922, viz. :—

PART V.

APPLICABILITY OF PROPOSED MINIMUM RATES.

The above proposed minimum rates of wages shall apply, subject to the provisions of the Trade Boards Acts, to all male and female workers as specified in Great Britain in respect of all time during which they are employed in any branch of the Linen and Cotton Handkerchief and Household Goods and Linen Piece Goods Trade as specified in Part IV of the Trade Board's Notice H.L. (8) dated 7th March, 1922.

The Trade Board will consider any OBJECTIONS to the above Proposals which may be lodged with them within two months from the 14th day of June, 1922. Such Objections should be in writing and signed by the person making the same (adding his or her full name and address) and should be sent to the Secretary, The Linen and Cotton Handkerchief and Household Goods and Linen Piece Goods Trade Board (Great Britain), 7-11, Old Bailey, London, E.C.4.

It is desirable that the Objections should state precisely, and, so far as possible, with reasons, what is objected to.
