

Protectorates belonging to nationals of the former Austrian Empire at the date when the said Treaty came into force (not being property rights or interests acquired under any general license issued by or on behalf of His Majesty), and the net proceeds of their sale, liquidation or other dealings therewith are charged by Article I. (IX.) of the above mentioned Orders in Council, must be made upon the prescribed forms and lodged with this Department in order to rank for payment of the first dividend to be declared by me out of the above mentioned property rights and interests belonging to nationals of the former Austrian Empire.
