

to charge for thermal units supplied in the form of gas; and

(b) the modification of the statutory or other provisions affecting the charges which may be made by the Undertakers by substituting for the maximum price per 1,000 cubic feet now authorised with an addition to meet increases in the costs and charges of and incidental to the production and supply of gas by the Undertakers since 30th June, 1914, a maximum price per therm (i.e., 100,000 British Thermal Units).

The maximum price now authorised in respect of the supply of gas by the Undertakers is five shillings and tenpence (5s. 10d.) per 1,000 cubic feet, and the price which the Undertakers have asked the Board of Trade to substitute for this price in accordance with paragraph (b) above is one shilling and sixpence per therm.

SALFORD ELECTRICITY.

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to the Electricity Commissioners by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of Salford (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation"), whose address is the Town Hall, Salford, for a Special Order under the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1922 for the following

or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

To apply to a certain road or portion of road outside the areas of supply under the Salford Electric Lighting Order 1890 and the Prestwich Electric Lighting Order 1900, the provisions of the said Acts which authorise or enable the Electricity Commissioners to authorise the breaking up of any road for the purpose of enabling electricity to be brought into the said areas of supply or one of them from a generating station intended to be erected by the Corporation upon a site in the Urban District of Swinton and Pendlebury abutting on Agecroft Road.

The road or portion of road to which it is proposed that the intended Order shall apply the said provisions is situate in the said Urban District and is the following:—

Agecroft Road from the boundary between the said Urban District of Swinton and Pendlebury and the Urban District of Prestwich to a point in Agecroft Road 725 feet or thereabouts south-westward of the said boundary.

To authorise the Corporation for the purpose of the undertakings authorised by the said Salford Electric Lighting Order 1890 and the Prestwich Electric Lighting Order 1900, or one of those undertakings, to open and break up the following streets or portions of streets in the said County Borough of Salford not repairable by the local authority (that is to say):—

Littleton Road from its junction with Mesnefield Road to Littleton Bridge;

Blandford Road between Hampton Road and Broughton Road.

And notice is hereby also given, that every local or other public authority, company or person being desirous of bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objection respecting the application may do so by registered letter addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Gwydyr House, Whitehall, S.W. 1, and despatched within thirty days from the 23rd day of September, 1922, and that a copy of such objection must also be forwarded to the undersigned or one of them.
