

westward along the middle of the said canal (thereby following in part the boundary which divides the New Parish of Saint Paul, Monton, in the said County and Diocese, from the said New Parish of Christ Church, Patricroft) for a distance of 1 mile and 8 chains or thereabouts to a point opposite to the middle of the stream which flows into Worsley Brook at Alder Forest, and extending thence south westward to and along the middle of the first mentioned stream (thereby passing under Barton Road) for a distance of 28 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Worsley Brook, and extending thence south eastward along the middle of Worsley Brook for a distance of $4\frac{1}{2}$ chains or thereabouts to the point where it meets the boundary of the Municipal Borough of Eccles, and extending thence first southward and then in various directions along such boundary (thereby continuing for a short distance to follow the middle of Worsley Brook) for a distance of 34 chains or thereabouts to the point where it meets the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Mark, Worsley, from the said New Parish of Christ Church, Patricroft, and extending thence first south eastward and then in various directions along the last mentioned boundary (thereby continuing to follow for the most part the boundary of the said Municipal Borough of Eccles) for a distance of 24 chains or thereabouts to the point where it turns northward along the middle of Worsley Brook, and extending thence southward along the middle of Worsley Brook for a distance of 8 chains or thereabouts to the centre of the culvert which carries the said Liverpool and Manchester Line of the London and North Western Railway across such brook, and extending thence eastward along the middle of the said line of railway for a distance of 42 chains or thereabouts to the centre of the bridge which carries such line of railway across the Bridgewater Canal, at which point the said imaginary line commenced."

And whereas the said Representation has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said Representation, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts.

And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said Diocese of Manchester.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the 8th and 9th Years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 70, of the Act of the 14th and 15th Years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 97, and of the Act of the 19th and 20th Years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 55, duly prepared and laid before His Majesty in Council a Representation, bearing date the 27th day of July, 1922, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for

England, in pursuance of the Act of the 8th and 9th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 70, of the Act of the 14th and 15th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 97, and of the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 55, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Representation as to the assignment of a Consolidated Chapelry to the consecrated Church of the Good Shepherd, Preston, Brighton, situate within the Parish of Preston, in the County of Sussex and in the Diocese of Chichester:

"Whereas at certain extremities of the said Parish of Preston and of the New Parish (sometime District Chapelry) of Saint Luke, Prestonville, in the said County and Diocese, which said extremities lie contiguous one to another, and are described in the Schedule hereunder written, there is collected together a population which is situate at a distance from the several churches of such Parish and New Parish respectively:

"And whereas it appears to us to be expedient that certain contiguous portions (being the portions containing the population aforesaid) of the said Parish of Preston and of the said New Parish of Saint Luke, Prestonville, should be formed into a Consolidated Chapelry for all Ecclesiastical purposes, and that the same should be assigned to the said Church of the Good Shepherd, Preston, Brighton, situate as aforesaid:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Winfrid Oldfield, Bishop of Chichester, as such Bishop and also as the Patron, in right of his See, of the Vicarage of the said Parish of Preston and as one of the Patrons of the Vicarage of the said New Parish of Saint Luke, Prestonville, and with the consents of Arthur Garry Copeman, Clerk in Holy Orders and Vicar or Incumbent of the said Vicarage of Preston, of John Francis William Deacon, of Number 20, Birchin Lane, in the City of London, Esquire, of William Graham Bradshaw, of Down Park, Crawley Down, in the said County of Sussex, Esquire, and of William Francis Courthope, of Number 20, Birchin Lane, in the said City of London, Esquire, as the remaining Patrons of the said Vicarage of the New Parish of Saint Luke, Prestonville (in testimony whereof they the said consenting parties have respectively signed and sealed this Representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, humbly represent, that it would, in our opinion, be expedient that all those contiguous portions of the said Parish of Preston and of the said New Parish of Saint Luke, Prestonville, which are described in the Schedule hereunder written, all which portions, together with the boundaries thereof, are delineated and set forth on the map or plan hereunto annexed, should be united and formed into one Consolidated Chapelry for the said Church of the Good Shepherd, Preston, Brighton, situate as aforesaid, and that the same should be named 'The Consolidated Chapelry of the Good Shepherd, Preston, Brighton.'
