WATER UNDERTAKINGS (MODIFICATION OF CHARGES) ACT, 1921.

LIMPSFIELD AND OXTED WATER COMPANY.

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Limpsfield and Oxted Water Company have made application to the Minister of Health under the above Act for an Order modifying Sections 53, 54 and 56 of the Limpsfield and Oxted Water Act, 1888, and Section 58 of that Act, as amended by Section 38 of the Limpsfield and Oxted Water Act, 1902, so as to enable them to make charges for water supply in the limits within which they are empowered to supply water, as follows:—

1. *Supply for domestic purposes:*

Where the rateable value of the premises—	Not exceeding

In respect of inns and hotels at a rate per centum on the rateable value (with a minimum charge of thirteen shillings and fourpence per annum) ... ..	12	0	0

The above rates are 33½ per cent. increase on the scale prescribed by Section 53 of the said Act of 1888.

In respect of every water closet beyond one an additional annual sum of ten shillings, and in respect of every bath an additional annual sum of twenty shillings, such sums being 33½ per cent. increase on the sums prescribed by Section 54 of the said Act of 1888.

2. *Supply by measure:*

In respect of supplies other than supplies for public purposes, a rate not exceeding 2s. 8d. per 1,000 gallons, such sum being 33½ per cent. increase on the sum prescribed by Section 58 of the said Act of 1888, as amended by Section 38 of the Act of 1902.
