55, have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Representation as to the assignment of a Consolidated Chapelry to the consecrated Church of Saint Paul, Westcliff, situate within the New Parish (sometime District Chapelry) of Saint Alban the Martyr, Westcliff, Southendon-Sea, in the County of Essex, and in the Diocese of Chelmsford:

"Whereas at certain extremities of the said New Parish of Saint Alban the Martyr, Westcliff, Southend-on-Sea, of the Parish of Prittlewell and of the New Parish (sometime District) of All Saints, Prittlewell, both in the said County and Diocese, which said extremities lie contiguous one to another, and are described in the Schedule hereunder written, there is collected together a population which is situate at a distance from the several churches of such new Parishes and Parish respectively:

"And whereas it appears to us to be expedient that certain contiguous portions (being the portions containing the populations aforesaid) of the said New Parish of Saint Alban the Martyr, Westcliff, Southend-on-Sea, of the said Parish of Prittlewell, and of the said New Parish of All Saints, Prittlewell, should be formed into a Consolidated Chapelry for all Ecclesiastical purposes, and that the same should be assigned to the said Church of Saint Paul, Westcliff, situate as aforesaid:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend John Edwin, Bishop of Chelmsford, as such Bishop and also as the Patron, in right of his See, as well of the Vicarage of the said New Parish of Saint Alban the Martyr, Westcliff, Southend-on-Sea, as of the Vicarage of the said Parish of Prittlewell, and with the consents of the Reverend Beresford James Kidd, Doctor in Divinity, the Warden of Keble College, Oxford, the Right Reverend Edward Stuart, Bishop of Winchester, the Right Honourable Hugh Richard Heathcote Cecil, a Member of Your Majesty's Commons House of Parliament, commonly called Lord Hugh Cecil, Sir John Walter Buchanan Riddell, of Number Beaufort Gardens, London, S.W., Baronet, and the Reverend William Charles Edward Newbolt, a Canon of the Cathedral Church of Saint Paul in London, as the Patrons of the said New Parish of All Saints, Prittlewell (in testimony whereof they, the said consenting parties, have respectively signed and sealed this Representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, humbly represent, that it would in our opinion, be expedient that all those contiguous portions of the said New Parish of Saint Alban the Martyr, Westcliff, Southend-on-Sea, of the said Parish of Prittlewell and of the said New Parish of All Saints, Prittlewell, which are described in the Schedule hereunder written, which portions, together with the boundaries thereof, are delineated and set forth on the map or plan hereunto annexed, should be united and formed into one Consolidated Chapelry for the said Church of Saint Paul, Westeliff, situate as aforesaid, and that the same should be named 'The Consolidated Chapelry of Saint Paul, Westcliff.'

"We, therefore, humbly pray that Your Majesty will be graciously pleased to take the premises into Your Royal consideration, and to make such Order in respect thereto as to Your Majesty in Your Royal Wisdom shall seem meet.

"THE SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Representation has reference.

"The Consolidated Chapelry of Saint Paul, Westcliff, comprising:

"All those contiguous portions of the New Parish (sometime 'District Chapelry) of Saint Alban the Martyr, Westcliff, Southend-on-Sea, of the Parish of Prittlewell and of the New Parish (sometime District) of All Saints, Prittlewell, all in the County of Essex and in the Diocese of Chelmsford, which, taken together, are comprised within and bounded by an imaginary line commencing at the junction of Leigh Road, Brightwell Avenue and West Road, where the boundaries of the New Parish of Saint Saviour, Westcliff, Southend-on-Sea, in the said County and Diocese, the said Parish of Prittlewell, and the said New Parish of Saint Alban Westcliff, Southend-on-Sea, Martyr, all meet, and extending thence first eastward and then north-eastward along the middle of West Road (thereby following in part the boundary which divides the of Prittlewell Parish from said New Parish of Saint Alban the Martyr, Westcliff, Southend-on-Sea) for a distance of 36½ chains or thereabouts to its junction with Tudor Road, and extending thence southward along the middle of Tudor Road for a distance of  $7\frac{1}{3}$  chains or thereabouts to its junction with North Road, upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of All Saints, Prittlewell, from the said Parish of Prittlewell, and extending thence southward along the middle of North Road (thereby following in part the last mentioned boundary and in part the boundary which divides the said New Parish of All Saints, Prittlewell, from the said New Parish of Saint Alban the Martyr, Westcliff, Southend-on-Sea) for a distance of 26 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Brighten Road, and extending thence southward along the middle of Brighten Road for a distance of 7 chains or thereabouts to its junction with London Road, where the boundaries of the said New Parish of All Saints, Prittlewell, the New Parish of Saint John the Baptist, Southend, in the said County and Diocese, and the said New Parish of Saint Alban the Martyr, Westcliff, Southend-on-Sea, all meet, and extending thence westward along the middle of London Road (thereby following the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Alban the Martyr, Westcliff, Southend-on-Sea, from the said New Parish of All Saints, Prittlewell) for a distance of 51 chains or thereabouts to its junction with North Road and Leigh Road, and extending thence northof westward along the middle Road (thereby following for a short distance the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Saviour, Westeliff, Southend-on-Sea from the said New Parish of Saint Alban the Martyr, Westcliff, Southend-on-Sea) for a distance of 37½ chains or thereabouts to its junction with Leigh Road and Brightwell Avenue where the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint Alban the Martyr, Westcliff, Southend-on-Sea, the said New Parish of Saint Saviour, Westcliff, Southend-on-Sea, and the said Parish of Prittlewell all meet, at which point the said imaginary line commenced.'
