DANGEROUS DRUGS ACT, 1920.

(10 & 11 Geo. V., Ch. 46.)

Notice is hereby given, under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Secretary of State for the Home Department, after the expiration of forty days from this date, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1920 (10 & 11 Geo. V., Ch. 46), to make Regulations amending the Regulations made on the 20th May, 1921, under Sections 3 and 7 of the above named Act.

The amending Regulations deal (a) with the issue of licences to procure the drugs as broker or agent, and (b) with the form of signatures

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on prescriptions given on the official form for National Health Insurance purposes.

GAS.

Order of the Board of Trade, dated January 1, 1923, under Section 7 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920 (10 and 11 Geo. V., c. 28), prescribing the rate of contribution to the Gas Fund for the year 1923.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Section 7 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920, the Board of Trade hereby prescribe that:—

1. The rate of contribution to the Gas Fund for the year 1923 shall be three shillings for each million cubic feet of gas sold during the year 1922.

2. Such contribution shall, on or before the 1st April, 1923, be paid to the Board of Trade, at Great George Street, London, S.W. 1, by any Gas Undertakers with respect to whom an order under the said Act shall have been made, by cheque made payable to the "Assistant Secretary for Finance, Board of Trade," and crossed "Gas Fund Account."
