COMMISSION OF SEWERS FOR THE FOBING LEVELS.

Alterations of Boundaries.

Notice is hereby given, that the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries has settled and made an Order, under the Land Drainage Act, 1918, extending the area under the jurisdiction of the above Commissioners by the inclusion therein of certain lands in the Parishes of Mucking, Stanford-le-Hope, Horndon-on-the-Hill, and certain other lands lying between Vange Wharf and Pitsea Station, in the County of Essex, and that the Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless within thirty days from the date of this Notice a memorial that the Order shall not become law without confirmation by Parliament is presented to the Ministry by some person or body affected by the Order and having such interest as is prescribed by Article 4 of the Land Drainage Regulations, 1918 (Statutory Rules and Orders, 1918, No. 1605), as being sufficient for the purpose.

A copy of the Sealed Order and of the 1/2,500 scale map referred to therein, and showing the extension of area, has been deposited at the residence of Mr. R. G. James, of Wharf Road, Stanford-le-Hope, for public inspection for the period of thirty days from the date hereof.

ORDER OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL
IN ENGLAND.

(Dated 13th January, 1923.)

Whereas under Section 21 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, the Registrar-General, with the sanction of the Minister of Health, may from time to time alter Registration Sub-districts:—

Now, therefore, I, Sylvanus Percival Vivian, Registrar-General of Births, Deaths and Marriages in England, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Births and Deaths Registration Acts, 1836 to 1901, and with the sanction of the Minister of Health, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Poplar Registration of Births, &c. (Alteration of Sub-districts) Order, 1923, and shall come into operation on the 1st February, 1923.

2. The Bromley Sub-district of Poplar Registration District shall cease to exist and its constituent Wards of Poplar Metropolitan Borough shall be apportioned as follows:—

(a) The Bromley North-West, Bromley North-East and Bromley South-West Wards shall be transferred to the Bow Sub-district of Poplar Registration District.

(b) The Bromley Central and Bromley South-East Wards shall be transferred to the Poplar Sub-district of the same Registration District.

3. The Sub-district of Bow as extended by this Order shall be re-named Bow and Bromley Sub-district.

4. The Registrar of the existing Bromley Sub-district shall be the Registrar of the Bow and Bromley Sub-district as constituted by this Order.
