THE WATER UNDERTAKINGS (MODIFICATION OF CHARGES) ACT, 1921.

NEW HUNSTANTON URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL.

Notice of Application to Minister of Health.

NOTICE is hereby given, that the New Hunstanton Urban District Council have made application to the Minister of Health under the above Act for an Order modifying section 16 of the New Hunstanton Water and Gas Act, 1897, and section 18 of the New Hunstanton Improvement Act, 1903, so as to enable them to make charges for water supply for domestic and trade purposes in the water limits within which they are empowered to supply water in accordance with the following scale:—

For Domestic Purposes.

Where the rateable value of the premises does not amount to £5, 11s. 6d. per annum.

Where the rateable value amounts to £5 but does not exceed £7, 14s. per annum.

Where the rateable value exceeds £7, 2s. in the £ upon such rateable value.

For Supplies by Measure (Meter).

Two shillings per 1,000 gallons.

A copy of the application and of all documents submitted to the Minister in connection therewith may be inspected and extracts thereof made free of charge at the Town Hall, New Hunstanton, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Copies of the documents may be purchased from the undersigned at the Town Hall, New Hunstanton, at the usual charges made for copying.

Any person desiring to make any representation or objection with reference to the application may do so by letter addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Health, Whitehall, London, S.W. 1, not later than the 20th February, 1923. A copy of any such representation or objection must be sent at the same time to the undersigned.
