PROPOSED PIECE-WORK BASIS TIME-RATE FOR ALL FEMALE WORKERS (OTHER THAN HOME-WORKERS).

Piece-Work Basis Time-Rate Proposed. 74d. per hour.

FOR ALL FEMALE WORKERS

In the case of all Female Workers employed on Piece-Work each piece-rate paid must be sufficient to yield, in the circumstances of the case, to an ORDINARY WORKER, i.e., a worker of ordinary skill and experience in the class of work in question at least 7½d. per hour.

PART III.

PROPOSED OVERTIME RATES FOR MALE AND FEMALE WORKERS (OTHER THAN HOME-WORKERS).

Overtime Rates calculated on the Proposed Minimum Rates specified in Parts I and II of thi Schedule in the manner set out in Part III of the Schedule to the above mentioned Notice O (13), shall apply in substitution for the Proposed Minimum Rates otherwise applicable, as set out in Parts I and II of this Schedule, in respect of all hours worked in excess of the number of hours declared by the Trade Board in the above-mentioned Notice O (13) to be the normal number of hours of work in the Trade.
