The Trade Board will consider any OBJECTIONS to the above PROPOSAL TO VARY which may be lodged with them within two months from the 2nd day of February, 1923. Such Objections should be in writing and signed by the person making the same (adding his or her full name and address), and should be sent to The Secretary of the Pin, Hook and Eye, and Snap Fastener Trade Board (Great Britain), 1, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1.

It is desirable that the Objections should state precisely, and, so far as possible, with reasons, what is objected to.

LAUNDRY TRADE BOARD (GREAT BRITAIN).

PROPOSAL TO VARY MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES FOR FEMALE WORKERS IN CORNWALL AND THE NORTH OF SCOTLAND (AS DEFINED IN PART III OF THE SCHEDULE TO THIS NOTICE).

In accordance with Regulations made under Section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, by the Minister of Labour and dated 31st October, 1918, and 1st August, 1922, the Trade Board established in Great Britain under the Trade Boards Acts, 1909 and 1918, for that branch of the Trade specified in the Trade Boards (Laundry) Order, 1919, as varied by the Trade Boards (Women's Clothing) Order, 1919, the Trade Boards (Shirtmaking) Order, 1920, and the Trade Boards (Linen and Cotton Handkerchief and Household Goods and Linen Piece Goods) Order, 1920, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE, as required by Section 3 (5) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, that they PROPOSE TO VARY the General Minimum Time-Rates, Piece-Work Basis Time-Rates, Guaranteed Time-Rates and Overtime Rates at present fixed and set out in their Notice W. (13) dated 29th June, 1922, in their application to Female Workers in Cornwall and the North of Scotland (as defined in Part III of the Schedule to this Notice), the proposed variations being as shown in the Schedule set out below.
