

New Parish of Saint Peter, Bradford Street, Farnworth, should be altered in the manner which is hereinafter mentioned:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend William, Bishop of Manchester (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme or Representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly represent, recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme or Representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint James, New Bury, the said New Parish of Saint Thomas, Dixon Green, and the said New Parish of Saint Peter, Bradford Street, Farnworth, shall be altered so that all those portions of the said New Parish of Saint James, New Bury, and of the said New Parish of Saint Peter, Bradford Street, Farnworth, which are described in the Schedule hereunder written and are delineated and set forth upon the Map or Plan hereunto annexed and are thereon coloured pink shall be dissevered from such New Parishes and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Saint Thomas, Dixon Green.

"And we further represent, recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing, recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts, or any of them, or any other Act of Parliament.

"THE SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

"The territory to be annexed to the New Parish of Saint Thomas, Dixon Green, in the County of Lancaster and in the Diocese of Manchester, being:—

"I. All that portion of the New Parish of Saint James, New Bury, in the said County and Diocese, which is bounded upon part of the south by the New Parish of Saint Peter, Bradford Street, Farnworth, in the said County and Diocese, upon the east and upon the north east by the said New Parish of Saint Thomas, Dixon Green, upon the north by the New Parish of Saint Michael, Great Lever, in the said County and Diocese, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the west, upon the south west, and upon the remaining part of the south by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Michael, Great Lever, from the said New Parish of Saint James, New Bury, at the junction of Harper Green Road with the roadway leading along the northern side of Lower Doe Hey Reservoir, and extending thence first southward and then south eastward along the middle of Harper Green Road for a distance of 46 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Plodder Lane, and extending thence eastward along the middle of Plodder Lane for a distance of 9 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Mossfield Road, and extending thence south westward along the middle of Mossfield Road for

a distance of 1 chain or thereabouts to its junction with Beatrice Street, and extending thence southward along the middle of Beatrice Street for a distance of $7\frac{1}{2}$ chains or thereabouts to its junction with Harrowby Street, and extending thence eastward along the middle of Harrowby Street for a distance of $6\frac{1}{2}$ chains or thereabouts to its junction with the roadway leading past the eastern side of Heaton Mill upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint James, New Bury, from the said New Parish of Saint Peter, Bradford Street, Farnworth.

"II. And also all that contiguous portion of the said New Parish of Saint Peter, Bradford Street, Farnworth, which is bounded upon all sides as follows, that is to say, upon part of the south and upon the west by the said New Parish of Saint James, New Bury, upon the north partly by the above-described portion of the said New Parish of Saint James, New Bury, and partly by the said New Parish of Saint Thomas, Dixon Green, upon the east by the District Parish of Farnworth and Kearsley, in the said County and Diocese, and upon the remaining part of the south by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said District Parish of Farnworth and Kearsley from the said New Parish of Saint Peter, Bradford Street, Farnworth, at the junction of Barncroft Road with King Street, and extending thence first south westward, then westward and then again south westward along the middle of King Street for a distance of 10 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Albert Road upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Peter, Bradford Street, Farnworth, from the said New Parish of Saint James, New Bury."

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme or Representation have been transmitted to the Patrons and to the Incumbents of the Cures affected by the arrangements which are contemplated by such Scheme or Representation and such Patrons and Incumbents have respectively signified their assent thereto:

And whereas the said Scheme or Representation has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said Scheme or Representation, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts.

And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said Diocese of Manchester.
