In the urban district of Kirkby-in-Ashfield—

Bridges carrying Southwell Lane and Victoria Road over the London and North Eastern Railway (Leen Valley Extensions).

Bridge carrying Cemetery Road (Mutton Hill) over the London Midland and Scottish Railway (Mansfield and Nottingham Railway).

Bridge carrying Lindley's Lane over the London Midland and Scottish Railway (Mansfield and Pinxton Railway).

Bridges carrying Lindley's Lane, Mill Lane, Grives Lane and Church Hill over the London and North Eastern Railway (Derbyshire Lines).
