ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 4TH DECEMBER, 1923.)

GREAT BRITAIN (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1923 (No. 8).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Extension of Infected Area No. 6.*

1. The Great Britain (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1923 (No. 5), hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order," and any Order amending that Order shall be read and have effect as if the Area described in the Schedule to this Order were included in and formed part of the Infected Area No. 6, described in the First Schedule to the Principal Order. The Area described in the Schedule hereto shall thereupon cease to form part of the Controlled Area.

*Short Title.*

2. This Order may be cited as the GREAT BRITAIN (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1923 (No. 8), and shall be read with the Principal Order.

SCHEDULE.

*Area added to Infected Area No. 6.*

1. An Area comprising:—

*In the administrative county of the Parts of Lindsey Division of Lincolnshire.*

The petty sessional divisions of Epworth, Scunthorpe, Barton, Brigg, Caistor, Market Rasen, Wragby, and Lincoln (Lindsey).

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 4TH DECEMBER, 1923.)

GREAT BRITAIN (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1923 (No. 9).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Modification of Principal Order.*

1. The Great Britain (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1923 (No. 5) (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order"), as amended by the Great Britain (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1923 (No. 6) and the Great Britain (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1923 (Nos. 7 and 8), is modified in the manner following:—

*Modification of Restrictions in certain Infected Areas.*

2. Infected Areas Nos. 3, 4 and 9 described in the First Schedule to the Principal Order shall cease to be Infected Areas for the purposes of that Order, and shall thereupon be included in and shall form part of the Controlled Area referred to in that Order.

*Contraction of certain Infected Areas.*

3. Infected Areas Nos. 7 and 10 described in the First Schedule to the Principal Order are hereby contracted so as to comprise only the areas described in the Schedule hereto, and the portions of the existing areas thereby excluded shall be included in and shall form part of the Controlled Area.

*Movement from Infected Area No. 2 to Infected Area No. 5 for Immediate Slaughter.*

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Principal Order, animals may be moved from premises (including a licensed fat stock market) in the Infected Area No. 2 described in the First Schedule to the Principal Order to any slaughterhouse in the Infected Area No. 5 described in that Schedule, if accompanied by a licence of the Local Authority of the district in which the slaughterhouse is situate.

Animals so moved shall be subject to the conditions as to movement, marking, and slaughter prescribed by the Principal Order in respect of animals being moved from a farm or licensed fat stock market in an Infected Area to a slaughterhouse in the same area.

*Movement of Imported Animals.*

5. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Principal Order imported animals landed at an approved Landing Place in the Controlled Area (except such Landing Places as are for the time being closed or limited to animals intended for slaughter within the landing place) may be moved direct by railway without being untrucked from the Landing Place to any destination not within the Controlled or Infected Areas to which the Principal Order
