NORTH MIDLANDS (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1923 (No. 16).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:

Landing of Animals at Birkenhead Landing Place.

1. The North Midlands (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1923 (No. 15) is hereby revoked, and the following Article is substituted for Article 2 (f) of the North Midlands (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1923 (No. 14) (hereinafter referred to as "The Principal

Order ''):—

(f) "The Landing of animals at the approved Landing Place at the Port of Liverpool (Birkenhead and Wallasey) is hereby prohibited except for animals intended for slaughter. Animals shall only be removed from the Landing Place direct to a slaughterhouse within (1) the Prohibited Area subject to the Principal Order, or (2) an Infected Area to which the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1923 applies. Animals so moved shall be subject to the provisions of the respective Orders applying to the areas in which the places of destination are situated."

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the fifteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty-three.

Short Title.

3. This Order may be cited as the North MIDLANDS (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER or 1923 (No. 16).
