" SCHEDULE II.

" Extra pay under the conditions specified in Articles 1468, 1468A, 1481, 1489, 1490, 1491, King's Regulations and Admiralty Instructions to be payable to Warrant Officers, Class II, Non-commissioned Officers, and Men of the Royal Marines on shore strength when casually employed on extra duty, but the rates paid not to exceed those authorised for similar regular appointments at Royal Marine Divisions.

" Allowances for care and custody of Mess

Traps to be payable at Royal Marine Establishments at the rates authorised for Royal Naval Shore Establishments."

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS by Section 8 of the Air Force (Constitution) Act, 1917, it is enacted that:—

(1) For the purpose of the administration of matters relating to the Air Force and to the defence of the realm by air there shall be established an Air Council consisting of one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, who shall be President of the Air Council, and of other members who shall be

appointed in such manner and subject to such provisions as His Majesty may, by Order in Council, direct.

(2) His Majesty may, by Order in Council, make provision with respect to the proceedings of the Air Council and the manner in which the business of the Council is to be distributed among the members thereof:

And whereas it is enacted by Section 6 of the Air Navigation Act, 1920, that the purposes of the Air Council shall include all matters connected with air navigation:

And whereas His Majesty, by Order in Council dated the 14th day of July, 1922, made provision with respect to the constitution
