AREAS) ORDER OF 1923 (No. 5).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Formation of Further Infected Area.

1. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1923, hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order," and any Order amending that Order shall be read and have effect as if the Area described in the Schedule to this Order were an Infected Area, described in the First Schedule to the Principal Order.
