The following Statutes made by the Governing Body of Sidney Sussex College, Cambridge, on the 8th day of May, 1923, and sealed by the University of Cambridge Commissioners on the 15th day of December, 1923, have been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of their having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923."

STATUTES to alter and amend the Statutes of Sidney Sussex College in the University of Cambridge, which amending Statutes were duly made at a Meeting of the Governing Body of the College, specially summoned for this purpose, and held on the eighth day of May one thousand nine hundred and twenty-three, and having been passed at such Meeting by the votes of more than two-thirds of the persons present and voting, are now submitted for the approval of His Majesty the King in Council.

We, the Master, Fellows and Scholars of the said College, in exercise of the powers given to us by the 54th Section of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1877, do hereby alter and amend the Statutes of our said College in manner following, that is to say:—

By repealing in Chapter XIII, intituled "Of the Bursar, the annual College Officers and the Audit of Accounts" the two concluding sen-

tences of the second paragraph and substituting therefor the two following sentences:—

"The Bursar shall submit his accounts, duly audited, to a College Meeting, once a year, within sixty days after Michaelmas. The Master shall give at least four weeks' notice of this Meeting to all the Fellows."

By substituting in Chapter XIX, intituled "Of Dividends," the word "yearly" for the word "half yearly" in the opening part of the second paragraph, and also in the third paragraph of this Statute.

By substituting the sum of "two hundred and fifty pounds (£250)" for the sum of "one hundred and twenty-five pounds (£125)" in the concluding part of the second paragraph and also in the third paragraph of the same Statute.

We, the University of Cambridge Commissioners, in pursuance of the powers conferred on us by Section 56 of the Schedule to the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923 (13 & 14 Geo. 5, ch. 33), do hereby consent that the herein contained amendments to Chapters XIII and XIX of the Statutes of Sidney Sussex College, be submitted to His Majesty in Council under the said Act.
