

SCHEDULE.

Description and Limits of Infected Places.

The following premises in the administrative county of Stafford:—

1. The whole of the buildings, the shippens and the yards, together with the adjoining field east of Summer Hill Road, at the Dairy, 30, Bradley Lane, in the occupation of Harold Bradley, in the parish of Coseley.

2. The whole of the buildings, the roadways and the stackyard, together with the fields known as The Pig Croft, The Shrubbery, and Orchard Croft at Booths Farm, in the occupation of Arthur Foden, in the parish of Perry Bar.

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1924 (No. 12).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Closing of Landing Place at Manchester.

1. The landing of animals at the approved Landing Place at the Port of Manchester is hereby prohibited.

Amendment of Description of Infected Area (No. 7).

2. The Second Schedule to the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1924 (No. 10) shall be read and have effect as if the parish of Cradley, in the administrative county of Hereford, were excluded from the Infected Area No. 7 described in that Schedule.

Short Title.

3. This Order may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1924 (No. 12).

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 5TH FEBRUARY, 1924.)

AYRSHIRE (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1924.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Meaning of Terms.

1. In this Order:—

“ The Controlled Area ” means the Area described in the Schedule hereto in which the movement of animals is hereby controlled. If any farm (excluding any detached part) is partly within and partly outside the Controlled Area, the whole shall be deemed to be within that area.

“ Animals ” means cattle, sheep, goats and pigs.

“ Slaughterhouse ” means premises used habitually and solely for the purpose of slaughtering animals, but does not include a slaughterhouse which forms part of a farm.

Restrictions in force in the Controlled Area.

2.—(a) No animal shall be moved out of the Controlled Area, except as provided in Article 3 of this Order.

(b) No animal shall be moved without a licence under Article 3 of this Order:—

(i) into the Controlled Area; or

(ii) along or across any road or other highway or by water within the Controlled Area.

(c) No animals shall be permitted by the owner or person in charge thereof to stray upon any road or other highway in the Controlled Area.

(d) No market, sale or exhibition of animals shall be held in the Controlled Area, except a market or sale of fat animals intended for immediate slaughter or a sale of animals on farm premises. A licence must be obtained from the Local Authority to hold any such market or sale, and a Veterinary Inspector of the Local Authority shall attend and examine the animals exposed thereat. No licence shall be granted for the holding of any such market or sale on any premises within a radius of five miles from any place infected with Foot-and-Mouth Disease.

(e) No slaughterhouse manure, refuse or offals, or other parts of a carcass intended for feeding animals shall be moved out of the Controlled Area or be brought into contact with animals in such Area.

(f) The landing of animals at the approved Landing Place at the Port of Ayr is hereby prohibited.

Movement of Animals by Licence into, within or out of the Controlled Area.

3. Licences may be granted by an Inspector
