BIRKENHEAD IMPORTED ANIMALS WHARF ORDER OF 1924.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Definition of Imported Animals Wharf.

1. The premises described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby defined as an Imported

Animals Wharf for the purposes of the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and any order of the Minister thereunder.

Revocation.

2. The Birkenhead Imported Animals Wharf Order of 1923 (No. 5) is hereby revoked.

Short Title.

3. This Order may be cited as the BIRKENHEAD IMPORTED ANIMALS WHARF ORDER OF 1924.
