

## ELECTRICITY (SUPPLY) ACTS 1882-1922.

## BARFORD AND DISTRICT SPECIAL ELECTRICITY ORDER.

NOTICE is hereby given that an Application is intended to be made to the Electricity Commissioners for a Special Electricity Order in respect of the Parish of Wasperton and of Parts of the Parishes of Barford and Sherborne in the Rural District of Warwick, the Parishes of Pillerton Priors, Pillerton Hersey and Butler's Marston in the Rural District of Brailes, the Parishes of Eatington, Kineton, Combrook, Compton Verney, Wellesbourne Hastings, Wellesbourne Mountford, Moreton Morrell, Newbold Pacey, Charlecote and Parts of the Parish of Hampton Lucy in the Rural District of Stratford-on-Avon, and the Parish of Lighthorne in the Rural District of Southam; all in the County of Warwick.

1. The Applicants for the Order are The Barford Electric Supply Company Limited whose registered office is situate at 66½ Corporation Street Birmingham.

2. The objects of the Application are to authorize the distribution by the Applicants of electricity within the Area of Supply hereinafter referred to, to authorize the fixing of prices to be charged to consumers in respect thereof, and generally in the terms of the Draft Order a copy of which has been deposited by the Applicants with the Electricity Commissioners.

## PROPOSED AREA OF SUPPLY.

3. So much of the Parish of Barford in the Rural District of Warwick as lies between an imaginary line on the North drawn East and West intersecting an imaginary point two miles due south from Warwick Town Hall and the Parish Boundaries on the East South and West. So much of the Parish of Sherborne in the Rural District of Warwick as lies between a line drawn on the North from a point where the parish boundary intersects the line between the Ordnance Marks 158 and 162 and thence along the line drawn through the Ordnance Mark 163 Ordnance Bench Mark 163.6 Ordnance Marks 159 163 168 Ordnance Bench Mark 174.3 Ordnance Marks 182 198 Ordnance Bench Mark 211.4 Ordnance Marks 239 and 268 to the parish boundary on the West the remainder of the parish boundary on the West in a southerly direction the parish boundary on the South and the parish boundary on the East. The whole of the Parish of Wasperton in the Rural District of Warwick. The whole of the Parishes of Eatington, Kineton, Combrook, Compton Verney, Wellesbourne Hastings, Wellesbourne Mountford, Morton Morrell, Newbold Pacey and Charlecote in the Rural District of Stratford-on-Avon. So much of the Parish of Hampton Lucy in the Rural District of Stratford-on-Avon as lies between a line drawn on the West from Ordnance Mark 298 in a southerly direction through Ordnance Mark 300 Ordnance Bench Marks 276.7 and 240.2 Ordnance Mark 217 Ordnance Bench Mark 193.4 Ordnance Mark 176 Ordnance Bench Mark 157.6 Ordnance Marks 145 129 and Ordnance Bench Mark 123.5 thence along the parish boundary on the West in a southerly direction the parish boundaries on the South and East and so much

of the parish boundary on the North as lies East of the aforesaid line forming the boundary on the West. The whole of the Parishes of Pillerton Priors, Pillerton Hersey and Butlers Marston in the Rural District of Brailes. The whole of the Parish of Lighthorne in the Rural District of Southam.

The word "Parish" or "Parishes" where referred to means the Parish or Parishes respectively as the same shall be constituted at the date of commencement of the Order as and when granted.

The boundaries above mentioned have reference to the latest reprint of the Ordnance Survey, six-inch scale.

4.—Railways which may be broken up by the undertakers in pursuance of the special powers granted by the orders.

Railway bridge at Kineton Station over the East and West Junction Railway.

Railway bridge at Eckington Station over the East and West Junction Railway.

5.—Streets and parts of streets throughout which the undertakers are to lay down suitable and sufficient distributing mains for the purpose of general supply within a period of two years after the commencement of this order.

*In the Rural District of Stratford-on-Avon:—*

Parish of Wellesbourne Hastings.—Warwick Road, School Street, Bridge Street, Church Street.

Parish of Wellesbourne Mountford.—Chapel Street, Shade Street.

Parish of Kineton.—Southam Street, Banbury Street, Warwick Road, Bridge Street.

*In the Rural District of Warwick:—*

Parish of Barford.—Church Street, Warwick Road, Wellesbourne Street to Gas Works, Keytes Lane, Mill Lane.

Parish of Sherbourne.—Sherbourne Corner Lane, Fullbrook Lane.

And notice is hereby further given that every local or other public authority, company, or person being desirous of bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objection respecting the Application may do so by registered letter addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Gwydyr House, Whitehall, London, S.W. 1, and despatched within thirty days from the date of the publication of the advertisement in this newspaper, and that a copy of such objection must also be forwarded to the undermentioned Solicitor, and Parliamentary Agent for the Order.
