#### UNIVERSITY OF LONDON.

AMENDMENT OF No. 108 OF THE STATUTES OF THE UNIVERSITY.

The Senate have this day adopted a Resolution for the amendment of No. 108 of the Statutes of the University, as follows:—

[Note.—The amendment consists in the addition of the words "(9) Bachelor of Pharmacy."]

108. The following degrees may be granted by the University (that is to say):—

- (1) Bachelor and Doctor of Divinity;
- (2) Bachelor and Master of Arts and Doctor of Literature;
- (3) Bachelor and Master and Doctor of Laws;
  - (4) Bachelor and Doctor of Music:
- (5) Bachelor and Doctor of Medicine, Bachelor and Master of Surgery, and Bachelor of Dental Surgery;

- (6) Bachelor and Master and Doctor of Science;
  - (7) Bachelor and Master of Commerce;
  - (8) Doctor of Philosophy;
  - (9) Bachelor of Pharmacy.
