

## (c) In the parish of Kennington—

Faversham Road from Church Lane to the Rose Public House, Vicarage Road from the School to a point one hundred and twenty yards east of the junction with Bockhanger Lane.

3. The streets and parts of streets not repairable by the local authority and the railways which the Council propose to take special powers by the Order to break up are as follows:—

## (A) In the Urban District of Ashford:—

(i) *Private Roads*—

Bond Road west of No. 133 Jemmett Road south of the house known as Grasmere Kings Avenue, Queens Road from Wall Road to Magazine Road, Rugby Gardens, Victoria Crescent, Victoria Road from its western junction with Victoria Crescent to School House William Road south of No. 24, Mabledon Avenue.

(ii) *Main Roads*—

Bank Street, Beaver Road, Canterbury Road, Castle Street, Chart Road, East Hill, Elwick Road, High Street, Godinton Road, Hythe Road, Kingsnorth Road, Magazine Road, Maidstone Road, New Street, North Street, Station Road.

(iii) *Roadways on Bridges*—

Roadways on bridges carrying the following roads over the Southern Railway (South Eastern and Chatham Line):—

Station Road, main road at Chart Leacon, bridge carrying footpath from cattle market to Victoria Park.

Roadways on bridges carrying the following roads over the Southern Railway (Maidstone and Ashford Line):—

Godinton Road, main road from Ashford to Maidstone, road from Ripton Farm to Maidstone Road, bridge carrying footpath from Godinton Road to Mather & Smith's Works.

## (B) In the Rural District of East Ashford.

(i) *Private Roads*—

Bath Road, Willesborough, Burton Road, Kennington, Kennington park estate road, Kennington Road from Smeeth to Aldington Corner, main road to Kent County Council quarry.

(ii) *Main roads*—

Charing to Canterbury main road;  
Ashford to Faversham main road;  
Ashford to Canterbury main road;  
Ashford to Hythe main road;  
Smeeth to Aldington Corner.

(iii) *Roadways on bridges*—

Roadway on bridge carrying road from Lower Ensden to Joan Beech Wood over the Southern Railway (South Eastern and Chatham Line) in the parish of Chilham.

Roadway on bridge carrying road from Ashford-Canterbury main road in an easterly direction to the south of Chilmans Downs over the Southern Railway (Ashford, Canterbury and Ramsgate Branch) in the parish of Chilham.

Roadway on bridge carrying road from Willesborough Lees to Kennington over the

Southern Railway (Ashford, Canterbury and Ramsgate Branch) in the parish of Kennington.

Roadway on bridge carrying Hythe Road over the Southern Railway (Ashford, Canterbury and Ramsgate Branch) in the parish of Willesborough.

Roadway on bridge carrying Canterbury Road at Crow Corner over the Southern Railway (South Eastern and Chatham Line) in the parish of Willesborough.

Roadway on bridge carrying road from Sevington to Sevington Bridges over the Southern Railway (South Eastern and Chatham Line) in the parish of Sevington.

Roadway on bridge carrying road from Mersham to Flood Street over the Southern Railway (South Eastern and Chatham Line) in the parish of Mersham.

Roadway on bridge over the Southern Railway (South Eastern and Chatham Line) 400 feet or thereabouts to the west of Smeeth Station in the parish of Smeeth.

Roadway on bridge carrying the road from Ladswood Farm to New House over the Southern Railway (Ashford and Hastings Branch) in the parish of Ruckinge.

(iv) *Level Crossings*—

Level crossing over the Southern Railway (Ashford Canterbury and Ramsgate Branch) at Wye Station in the parish of Wye.

Level crossing over the Southern Railway (South Eastern and Chatham Line) at Aylesford Green in the parish of Willesborough.

## (c) In the Rural District of West Ashford—

(i) *Main Roads*—

Maidstone to Ashford main road;  
Charing to Faversham main road;  
Charing to Canterbury main road;  
Charing to Smarden main road;  
Ashford to Bromley Green main road;  
Ashford to Bethersden main road.

(ii) *Roadways on bridges*—

Roadway on bridge carrying road from Buttesland Farm to Buttesland Wood over the Southern Railway (Ashford and Hastings Branch) in the parish of Kingsnorth.

Roadways on bridges carrying the following roads over the Southern Railway (South Eastern and Chatham Line) in the parish of Great Chart, namely—

- (1) from South Lodge to Godinton Park;
- (2) from Ninn Lodge to Worten Farm;
- (3) from Worten Farm to Brockhurst Wood;

Roadway on bridge carrying road from Hoads Wood to Rippers Cross over the Southern Railway (South Eastern and Chatham Line) in the parish of Bethersden.

Roadway on bridge carrying road from Dowe Street to Dynes Farm over the Southern Railway (South Eastern and Chatham Line) in the parish of Bethersden.

Roadway on bridge at Pluckley Station in the parish of Pluckley.

Roadway on bridge carrying the road from Maltmans Hill to Pluckley Thorne over the Southern Railway (South Eastern and Chatham Line) in the parish of Smarden.
