

Street to the intersection of Lower Ford Street, thence northward along the western boundary of All Saints Ward as hereinbefore defined to the boundary of Hill Fields Ward at the intersection of Yardley Street, thence westward and northward along the boundary of Hill Fields Ward as hereinbefore defined to the boundary of Harnall Ward at the intersection of Victoria Street, thence south-westward and westward along the southern boundary of Harnall Ward as hereinbefore defined to the boundary of Radford Ward at the intersection of King Street, thence westward along the southern boundary of Radford Ward as hereinbefore defined to the boundary of Bablake Ward at the intersection of Hill Street, thence south-eastward along the north-eastern boundary of Bablake Ward as hereinbefore defined to the boundary of Grey Friars Ward at the intersection of Fleet Street, thence eastward along the northern boundary of Grey Friars Ward as hereinbefore defined to the point of commencement aforesaid.

"Cheylesmore Ward.

"A line commencing at a point in the centre of Stoney Road on the City boundary, running south-eastward and north-eastward along the said City boundary to the intersection of Binley Road, thence north-westward along the centre of Binley Road to the boundary of All Saints Ward at the intersection of St. George's Road, thence southward, westward and northward along the southern boundary of All Saints Ward as hereinbefore defined to the boundary of St. Mary's Ward at the intersection of Gosford Bridge, thence westward along the southern boundary of St. Mary's Ward as hereinbefore defined to the boundary of Grey Friars Ward at the intersection of Hertford Street, thence south-westward and south-eastward along the eastern boundary of Grey Friars Ward as hereinbefore defined to the point of commencement aforesaid.

"Stoke Ward.

"A line commencing at a point in the centre of Binley Road on the City boundary and the boundary of Cheylesmore Ward, running southward, eastward, northward and westward along the said City boundary to the boundary of Swanswell Ward at the intersection of Mercer Avenue, thence southward along the eastern boundary of Swanswell Ward as hereinbefore defined to the boundary of Hill Fields Ward at the intersection of Heath Road, thence southward and westward along the eastern and southern boundaries of Hill Fields Ward as hereinbefore defined to the boundary of All Saints Ward at the intersection of Brighton Street, thence southward along the eastern boundary of All Saints Ward as hereinbefore defined to the boundary of Cheylesmore Ward at the intersection of Binley Road, thence south-eastward along the north-eastern boundary of Cheylesmore Ward to the point of commencement aforesaid.

"The boundaries of the Wards as above described are delineated on the Plan annexed hereto which forms part of the Scheme.

"II. APPORTIONMENT OF COUNCILLORS.

"The three councillors in office for each ward as existing at the date of this Scheme

shall be the councillors for the ward of the same name as altered by this Scheme.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the 33rd and 34th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 39, and of the Acts therein mentioned, that is to say, the Act of the 3rd and 4th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 113, the Act of the 4th and 5th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 39, and the Act of the 31st and 32nd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 114, duly prepared, and laid before His Majesty in Council, a Scheme, bearing date the 27th day of November, 1924, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in pursuance of the Act of the 33rd and 34th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 39, and of the Acts therein mentioned, that is to say, the Act of the 3rd and 4th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 113, the Act of the 4th and 5th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 39, and the Act of the 31st and 32nd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 114, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme for effecting a transfer of the ownership of the Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the Church and Cure (hereinafter called 'the said Benefice') of Bishopton, in the County of Durham and in the Diocese of Durham:

"Whereas the Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Bishopton is vested for an estate in fee simple without incumbrances in John George Wilson, of Number 5, North Bailey, in the City of Durham, Solicitor:

"And whereas the said John George Wilson is desirous that the whole Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Bishopton, now vested in him as aforesaid, should be transferred to and be vested in the Bishop of Durham for the time being:

"And whereas the Right Reverend Herbert Hensley, now Bishop of Durham, is willing to accept such transfer, and in token of such his willingness and also in token that the same transfer has that consent of the Bishop of the Diocese which by the Acts in the hereinbefore mentioned Act recited or by some or one of them is made necessary, he, the said
