ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 9TH MARCH, 1925.)

FOOT - AND - MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1925, (No. 15).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Contraction of certain Infected Area.

1. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1925 (No. 13) shall be read and have effect as if the area described in the First Schedule to this Order were substituted for the Infected Area described in the Schedule to that Order.

Revocation of certain Orders.

2. The Orders described in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby revoked.
